RE: Increase in nursery fees from 1st April 2019

As you are aware, we conduct a review of fees of each year. The table below shows the new fees to be applied from April 2019. The funded figures are based on the government funding rate applied to the current year. Should this rate change, the funded fees will be amended accordingly.

We are making you aware of the forthcoming changes to fees now, in order for parents to have sufficient time to make the necessary arrangements regarding funding sources such as Universal Credits.

To support parents with childcare costs for children of all ages the Government introduced the Tax-Free Childcare scheme which is available to around 2 million households. You can open an online account which you can pay into to cover your cost of childcare, for every 80p you pay in the government will top up your account with an extra 20p.
